Nova Group, Inc-Underground Construction, AJV and a prime contractor, requests sub bids from all interested small business entities, Small Business Administration (SBA) certified small disadvantaged business entities, including minority and women-owned, HUBZone small business entities, veteran-owned small and service-disabled veteran-owned small businesses in the following areas:

Description:

Construction of the largest naval fuel facility.

Eight each 125,000-barrel multi-product fuel storage tanks, fuel distribution piping, pumphouse, fuel oil reclamation (FOR) facilities, and a lube oil storage and dispensing system. Also fuel tanker truck loading and unloading stations, fuel icing inhibitor injection system, and pier-side operations control tower.

Work required for site preparations and improvements include extensive earthwork operations, earth retaining structures, pavements, storm and sanitary sewers, sedimentation basins, landscaping, fencing, site lighting, electrical distribution systems, and emergency power generators. Relocate small security office and improve secondary entrance gate for truck traffic to accommodate new work.

Environmental abatement and mitigation of hazardous items during the demolition of multiple buildings and the removal or closure of 30 each aboveground/underground fuel storage tanks, totaling greater than one million barrels of fuel storage capacity, plus other FOR and lube oil tanks of varying sizes.

The project also includes extensive remediation of fuel contaminated soil, automated fuel handling and tank gauging equipment, and physical security equipment funded by other appropriations. The approximate value of the entire project is \$140,000,000.

Supply items include:

Waste Disposal; Fuel; Chemical Toilets; Concrete; Aggregates; Trucking; Surveying; pipe, valve and fitting Vendors for Fuel, Sewer, Water Storm Drain and Electrical systems.

Building construction for pre-engineered metal frame and CMU block structures with standing seam metal roof, flooring, HVAC, plumbing, drywall and interior electrical. Civil work to remove and grade the existing soil, construction of retaining walls and sediment basins.

Demolition of existing buildings, fuel removal and tank cleaning, asbestos and lead based paint abatement, contaminated soil and water handling -- sampling, analyzing and transporting non-hazardous and hazardous disposal.

Other subcontracting items include:

Rebar, Tank Construction and Tank Painting, Containment Liner and Concrete Cast-in-place Containment Dike Walls, Painting, Fencing, Fire Detection, Pavement Markings, Landscaping, Asphalt Paving and Concrete Paving.
